ICEFLU WOMEN'S ONLINE MEETING

On **March 8th**, the ICEFLU Women's Workgroup held an online meeting. The group has been organizing since July 2020 to mobilize a group to consider issues related to the protection, equity and respect for the women of our churches. The meeting was attended by several Madrinhas from Mapiá along with the writer **Moema Viezzer**, who gave a lecture on women's struggles and conquests.



IMPROVEMENTS IN THE ARCHIVAL OFFICE

CEDOC concluded an important phase of its development with the installation of a second air conditioner and a dehumidifier, along with several other improvements for the room holding a collection of original archival material. With the support of ICEFLU and INE, we are continuing our work in 2021.



MAPIÁ: A YEAR OF

It has already been a year since AMVCM released the official ICEFLU note establishing guidelines for associated churches in relation to the pandemic. In the past seven months, access to Mapiá has been restricted to residents of the community, which still remains closed to visitors and remains in internal isolation. In February, the first case of Covid-19 in the community was recorded. To date, 37 cases have been confirmed, without any serious complications.

CONSTRUCTION OF THE LUA BRANCA CULTURE, SPORTS AND RECREATION CENTER - CCEL

The Youth and Events Sector restarted the construction of CCEL Lua Branca. The renovation of the gym floor, construction of the playground and the gate, as well as the installation of plumbing all occurred before the pandemic. Capoeira classes by the Cipó de Ouro group and activities with young people and children were already underway. Now the soccer field, benches, paint and final touches will be made.





WORLD SOLIDARITY CAMPAIGN

ICEFLU and **AMVCM**, with support from Santa Casa, IDARIS, Cruzeiro do Céu School, INE, ISAVIÇOSA and other institutions, carried out a successful campaign which raised more than R\$97k. This enabled the purchase and distribution of food and basic household items for 250 families, the acquisition of health equipment and an emergency assistance fund for the community. AID TO FLOODED

A **PROBIM** (The Mapiá River Producers' Organization) represents of the residents of Fazenda São Sebastião, Praia Gregório and Dom João. After meeting with AMVCM and IDARIS, the group sent a letter to the mayor of Pauini and to the ICMBIO asking for support for the flooded areas of the Purus River. ICMBIO has already sent basic food and household items and the mayor promises the same. The Interinstitutional Workgroup is evaluating how to meet the demands of the 40 affected families. RENOVATION OF THE MAIN BUILDING

The **renovation work** on the original Santa Casa building continues. At the moment, the waters of the igarapé are used to transport the building materials for the project, including those necessary for the sanitary facilities that will serve the church when in-person works return to our calendar. Due to the project timeline of our new Mother Church, the spiritual works will still be carried out for some time in the Santa Casa.



ROSARY OF SÃO MIGUEL

In **February**, Santa Casa invited Mapiá and the worldwide irmandade to join a great healing current with the Rosary of São Miguel daily at 6 pm. Padrinho Alfredo invited everyone to start a series of São Miguel works, which were carried out during the first half of March. Many families and churches followed this on Radio Jagube, with a request for healing, protection and security for our fellowship.

WOMEN BRING DIVERSITY AND QUALITY TO FOOD PRODUCTION

The Women's project of the Agroecology and Food Sovereignty Program is the result of the effort and the union of a group of women from Mapiá who fight for a healthy diet. They cultivate manioc, rice, corn, beans, fruit and large trees in six gardens. The cultivation of vegetables, fruits and various vegetables is done in a productive backyard. The group also collaborates with the processing at the Agroecology Production Center, producing flours, sweets and preserves.

DARIO RAIMUNDO IBACETA MEZA

(*13/09/1950 +27/02/2021). The Chilean of seven tools', as Lúcio Mortimer called him. The magical flutist, artist, inventor, mechanic, carpenter, woodworker. The head of the bateção, untiring fiscal of the works, jack-ofall-trades in the community work days. He painted the historic facade of the church at Colonia Cinco Mil. Uncle Dário to the children and youths. He left to reinforce the team in the astral. He leaves his wife, three children, four grandchildren, along with his irmãos, friends, godchildren and companions.



JOÃO BATISTA DE ARAÚJO GUERRA

(*27/11/1947+19/03/2021). João Guerra, a São Paulo native who was a resident of Vila Céu do Mapiá for decades, made his move to another dimension. Sociologist, professor, farmer and writer, he was a dedicated researcher in agroecology. His inspired poetic chronicle "Nave Mãe" reported the daily life of the community and the church, elaborated upon the position of the stars and interlaced hymns of the moment. He is missed by many friends, godchildren and brothers.



MARIA SIQUEIRA DA SILVA

(*16/09/1923+26/03/2021)

Affectionately called '**Vó Nogueira**', she was born on September 16th, 1923 in Acre. She suffered from a disease that doctors were unable to treat. Disillusioned, she sought the Daime, was received by Mestre Irineu in Alto Santo, and was cured. After Mestre passed, she followed Padrinho Sebastião, living in Colônia Cinco Mil and Mapiá. She was known for her prayers and blessings, and as an excellent midwife. The community will miss this beautiful and precious Madrinha.
